Fire Pit Inspection and Approval > Checklist



Please use the following checklist to ensure that you have completed all necessary steps to receive approval for the installation and use of an outdoor fire pit.

- 1. Apply for and receive appropriate permits for your lot (e.g. Access, Building, or Minor Campground)
- 2. Review all county regulations and requirements for fire pits (See Utah County Code Chapters 9 Fire Prevention and Protection; Utah County Fire Marshal Outdoor Fire Requirements). Please note there are some County requirements in addition to HOA requirements to be aware of (e.g. pit diameter cannot exceed 36 inches)
- 3. Review all CC&R regulations and requirements for fire pits
- 4. Build and install your fire pit in compliance with the CC&Rs and county regulations and requirements
- 5. Schedule and have an inspection by the Utah County Fire Marshal. Make sure the Fire Marshal signs that your fire pit passed inspection on your lot's Soldier Summit Estates Fire Pit Inspection Form (See Soldier Summit Estates Fire Pit Inspection and Approval Form).
- 6. Schedule and have an inspection by the Safety, Security, and Compliance Coordinator or other board member. Bring your Soldier Summit Estates Fire Pit Inspection and Approval Form signed by the Fire Marshall.
- 7. Do not have any fires until your fire pit has passed both inspections
